### LIONS WATCH PROGRAM HOURS:

2:55 pm-5:30 pm-All Scheduled **Full** School Days

*\*The Lions Watch Program is not available for early dismissal days, teacher-in-service days, scheduled school breaks or any holiday when school is not in session\* Lions Watch begins the first full week of school Monday, August 23, 2021. There is no Lions Watch Tuesday December 14 due to the school-wide Christmas program. The last day of Lions Watch is Wednesday June 1, 2022.*

### LIONS WATCH PROGRAM RATES 2021-2022:

MONTHLY \$125.00 (August, December, April)  
\$160.00 (September-November,  
January-March, May)

Lions Watch billing must be kept current to remain in the program.

### LATE PICK-UP POLICY:

Because the Lions Watch Program closes at 5:30 p.m. sharp, we do not have staff scheduled past that time. Picking up your child after 5:30 p.m. imposes a hardship on our staff. A late pick-up fee is charged for each child who is picked up after 5:31 p.m. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for the first five (5) minutes and \$1.00 for every additional minute.

### LIONS WATCH ENROLLMENT:

Space in Lions Watch is limited and will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Monthly scheduled participation in Lions Watch can be reserved during certain seasons by contacting the Lions Watch Director. (Examples: different sports seasons, rehearsals or academic practices in which siblings are participating) A Lions Watch Emergency Information Form must be on file with the director prior to participation in the Lions Watch Program. A two-week notice must be submitted to the director for withdrawal from the program.

### ABSENCES:

All Lions Watch Program fees will be charged based on reserved days including missed days due to illness, parent vacations, etc. No refunds or deductions can be made for days your child is absent on reserved days.

### BEHAVIOR:

Students are expected to follow the HTCCS Code of Conduct at all times during Lions Watch. Repeated disregard of the rules or behavior that disrupts the Lions Watch program will result in a phone call to come pick up the child immediately. Repeated disruptions could result in removal from the program.

### UNATTENDED CHILDREN ON SCHOOL GROUNDS AFTER SCHOOL HOURS:

All children in grades K-7th on school grounds after dismissal must be under the supervision of a parent, caregiver, teacher or coach. Any unattended child on school grounds after dismissal will be taken to the front office until supervision arrives.

### ILLNESS:

The Lions Watch Program does not have the ability to care for a child who becomes ill during Lions Watch hours. Should a child become ill (in accordance with the HTCCS illness and COVID-19 guidelines) during Lions Watch hours, the parent, caregiver or emergency contact will be notified and expected to make **immediate** arrangements to pick up the sick child.

### PROGRAM NOTES:

The Aftercare Program will include:

- Snack time (snacks and water bottles provided by the participant)
- Recreation Time
- Supervised Homework Time (This is not to be considered tutoring. Parents or caregivers are expected to review all work and to add any signatures needed to homework, tests, agendas, reading logs or progress reports)
- Various crafts, games, and enrichment activities
- ***ALL HTCCS COVID-19 Protocols are in effect during After Kinder and Lions Watch activities.***
